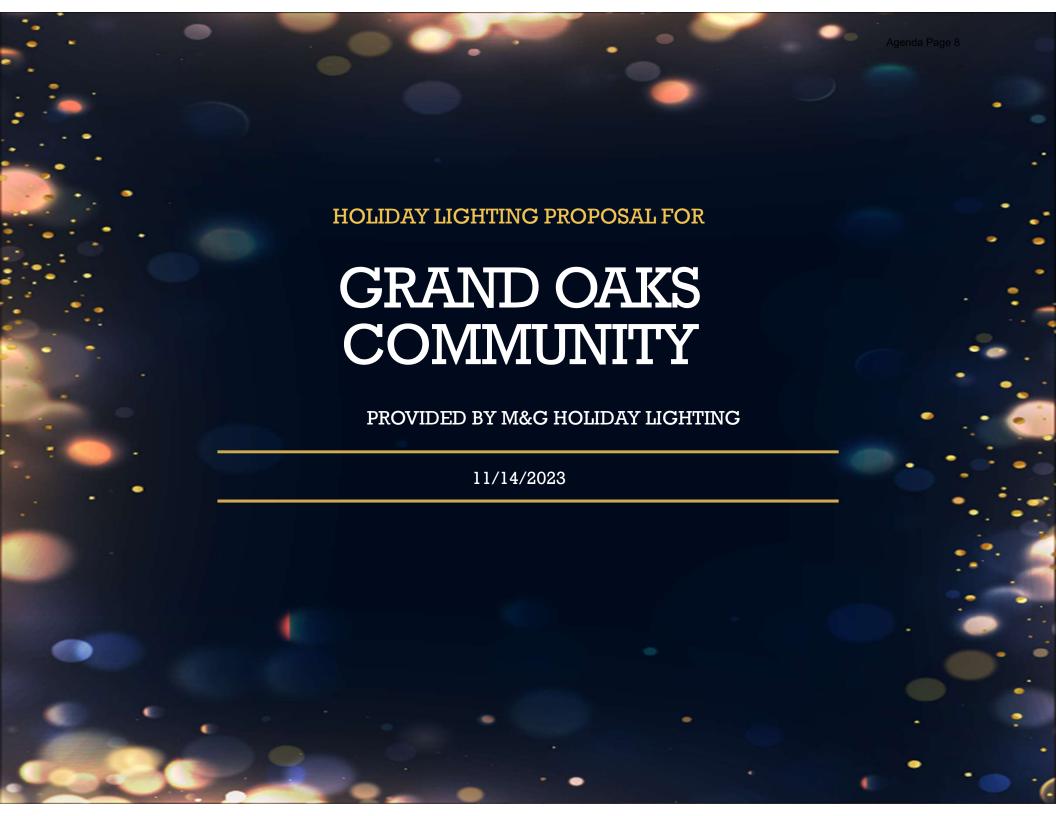

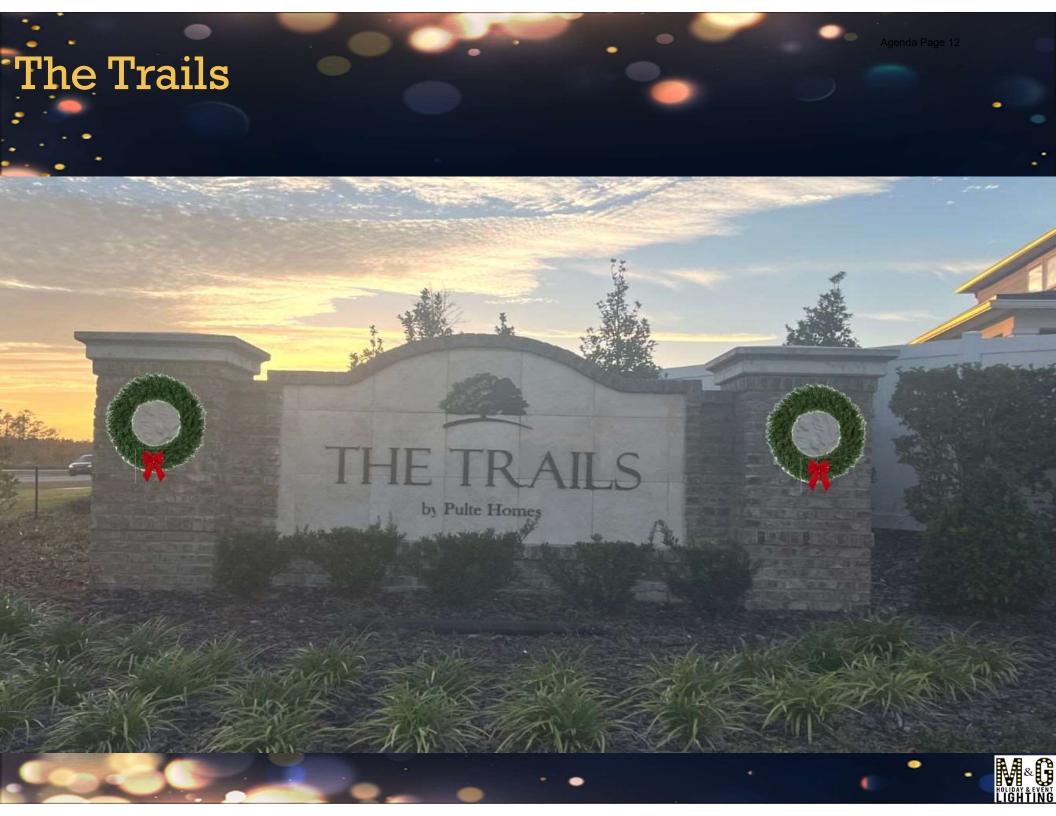

- Mr. Hyatt expressed security concerns.
- The current hours are 5:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

On MOTION by Mr. Hyatt seconded by Ms. Corob with all in favor keeping the current operational hours for the gym was approved and the request to open 24 hours was declined.

- Mr. Koncar requested a motion authorizing staff to work with District Counsel on completing insurance requirements and approvals for the purpose of having food trucks on District property. He also asked the Board if they want to charge the food trucks to come on District property.
- Board discussion ensued on whether to charge the food trucks.

On MOTION by Mr. Hyatt seconded by Mr. Harris with all in favor District staff was authorized to work with District Counsel on completing all insurance requirements and approvals for the purpose of having food trucks come on District property and left the choice on whether to charge a fee to the food trucks to staff's discretion.

Mr. Koncar reviewed pest control proposals for the Amenity Center from All U Need
Pest Control and Home Team Pest Control. He recommended All U Need Pest
Control because they have more comprehensive services and services six times a year
as opposed to four times a year.

On MOTION by Mr. Hyatt seconded by Mr. Harris with all in favor the Chairman was authorized to execute a contract with All U Need Pest Control subject to legal review and approval.

Mr. Koncar noted security issues have been discussed in the past. He requested
authorization for the Chairman, District Counsel and himself to obtain quotes and
enter into a contract for security monitoring services, which will include the Amenity
Center and the pool house area.

On MOTION by Mr. Hyatt seconded by Mr. Harris with all in favor the Chairman, District Counsel and the District Manager were authorized to obtain proposals and enter into a contract for security monitoring services.

- Additional cameras were discussed. Mr. Eckert noted camera locations cannot be
 discussed in a public meeting. The Board can authorize the installation of cameras
 and it is up to staff to determine where the appropriate places are.
- They received a proposal from MDH for additional cameras at a total cost of \$2,315.11.

On MOTION by Mr. Hyatt seconded by Mr. Harris with all in favor the proposal from MDH for additional cameras was approved at a total cost not to exceed \$2,315.11.

- Mr. Koncar reviewed the bids for the landscaping contract. This is the third time they
 bid landscape services this year. They expanded the scope of services in the most
 recent bid.
- Staff recommends The Greenery with an annual base cost of \$229,008. There is an annual ancillary cost of \$39,843. They will also provide mulch and flowers four times a year. Their hourly irrigation rate is \$75 per hour.

ADA Website Accessibility and Florida F.S. 189.069 Requirements



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Compliance Audit Overview

The Community Website Compliance Audit (CWCA) consists of a thorough assessment of Florida Community Development District (CDD) websites to assure that specified district information is available and fully accessible. Florida Statute Chapter 189.069 states that effective October, 2015, every CDD in the state is required to maintain a fully compliant website for reporting certain information and documents for public access.

The CWCA is a reporting system comprised of quarterly audits and an annual summary audit to meet full disclosure as required by Florida law. These audits are designed to assure that CDDs satisfy all compliance requirements stipulated in Chapter 189.069.

Compliance Criteria

The CWCA focuses on the two primary areas – website accessibility as defined by U.S. federal laws, and the 16-point criteria enumerated in <u>Florida Statute Chapter</u> 189.069.



ADA Website Accessibility

Several federal statutes (American Disabilities Act, Sec. 504 and 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973) require public institutions to ensure they are not discriminating against individuals on the basis of a person's disability. Community websites are required to conform to web content accessibility guidelines – WCAG 2.1, which is the international standard established to keep websites barrier-free and the recognized standard for ADA-compliance.



Florida Statute Compliance

Pursuant to F.S. <u>189.069</u>, every CDD is required to maintain a dedicated website to serve as an official reporting mechanism covering, at minimum, 16 criteria. The information required to report and have fully accessible spans: establishment charter or ordinance, fiscal year audit, budget, meeting agendas and minutes and more. For a complete list of statute requirements, see page 3.

Audit Process

The Community Website Compliance Audit covers all CDD web pages and linked PDFs.* Following the <u>WCAG 2.1</u> levels A, AA, and AAA for web content accessibility, a comprehensive scan encompassing 312 tests is conducted for every page. In addition, a human inspection is conducted to assure factors such as navigation and color contrasts meet web accessibility standards. See page 4 for complete accessibility grading criteria.

In addition to full ADA-compliance, the audit includes a 16-point checklist directly corresponding with the criteria set forth in Florida Statute Chapter 189.069. See page 5 for the complete compliance criteria checklist.

* NOTE: Because many CDD websites have links to PDFs that contain information required by law (meeting agendas, minutes, budgets, miscellaneous and ad hoc documents, etc.), audits include an examination of all associated PDFs. PDF remediation and ongoing auditing is critical to maintaining compliance.

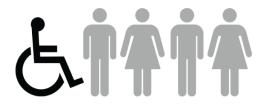

Accessibility overview

Everyone deserves equal access.

With nearly 1-in-5 Americans having some sort of disability – visual, hearing, motor, cognitive – there are literally millions of reasons why websites should be fully accessible and compliant with all state and federal laws. Web accessibility not only keeps board members on the right side of the law, but enables the entire community to access all your web content. The very principles that drive accessible website design are also good for those without disabilities.

The legal and right thing to do

Several federal statutes (American Disabilities Act, Sec. 504 and 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973) require public institutions to ensure they are not discriminating against individuals on the basis of a person's disability. Community websites are required to conform to web content accessibility guidelines, WCAG 2.1, the international standard established to keep websites barrier-free. Plain and simple, any content on your website must be accessible to everyone.



ADA Compliance Categories

Most of the problems that occur on a website fall in one or several of the following categories.



Contrast and colors

Some people have vision disabilities that hinder picking up contrasts, and some are color blind, so there needs to be a distinguishable contrast between text and background colors. This goes for buttons, links, text on images – everything. Consideration to contrast and color choice is also important for extreme lighting conditions.

Using semantics to format your HTML pages

When web page codes are clearly described in easy-to-understand terms, it enables broader sharing across all browsers and apps. This 'friendlier' language not only helps all the users, but developers who are striving to make content more universal on more devices.



Text alternatives for non-text content

Written replacements for images, audio and video should provide all the same descriptors that the non-text content conveys. Besides helping with searching, clear, concise word choice can make vivid non-text content for the disabled.

Ability to navigate with the keyboard

Not everyone can use a mouse. Blind people with many with motor disabilities have to use a keyboard to make their way around a website. Users need to be able to interact fully with your website by navigating using the tab, arrows and return keys only. A "skip navigation" option is also required. Consider using WAI-ARIA for improved accessibility, and properly highlight the links as you use the tab key to make sections.

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Easy to navigate and find information

Finding relevant content via search and easy navigation is a universal need. Alt text, heading structure, page titles, descriptive link text (no 'click here' please) are just some ways to help everyone find what they're searching for. You must also provide multiple ways to navigate such as a search and a site map.

Properly formatting tables

Tables are hard for screen readers to decipher. Users need to be able to navigate through a table one cell at a time. In addition to the table itself needing a caption, row and column headers need to be labeled and data correctly associated with the right header.

PDF files must be tagged properly to be accessible, and unfortunately many are not. Images and other non-text elements within that PDF also need to be ADA-compliant. Creating anew is one thing; converting old PDFs – called PDF remediation – takes time.

Making videos accessible

Simply adding a transcript isn't enough. Videos require closed captioning and detailed descriptions (e.g., who's on-screen, where they are, what they're doing, even facial expressions) to be fully accessible and ADA compliant.

Forms are common tools for gathering info and interacting. From logging in to registration, they can be challenging if not designed to be web-accessible. How it's laid out, use of labels, size of clickable areas and other aspects need to be considered.

Alternate versions

Attempts to be fully accessible sometimes fall short, and in those cases, alternate versions of key pages must be created. That is, it is sometimes not feasible (legally, technically) to modify some content. These are the 'exceptions', but still must be accommodated.



Feedback for users

To be fully interactive, your site needs to be able to provide an easy way for users to submit feedback on any website issues. Clarity is key for both any confirmation or error feedback that occurs while engaging the page.



Other related requirements

No flashing

Blinking and flashing are not only bothersome, but can be disorienting and even dangerous for many users. Seizures can even be triggered by flashing, so avoid using any flashing or flickering content.

Timers

Timed connections can create difficulties for the disabled. They may not even know a timer is in effect, it may create stress. In some cases (e.g., purchasing items), a timer is required, but for most school content, avoid using them.

Fly-out menus

Menus that fly out or down when an item is clicked are helpful to dig deeper into the site's content, but they need to be available via keyboard navigation, and not immediately snap back when those using a mouse move from the clickable area.

No pop-ups

Pop-up windows present a range of obstacles for many disabled users, so it's best to avoid using them altogether. If you must, be sure to alert the user that a pop-up is about to be launched.

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INTRODUCTION

The Grand Oaks Community Development District ("District") is a local unit of special-purpose government created pursuant to and existing under the provisions of Chapter 190, Florida Statutes. Under Florida law, community development districts are required to take affirmative steps to provide for the full disclosure of information relating to the public financing and maintenance of improvements to real property undertaken by such districts. Unlike city and county governments, the District has only certain limited powers and responsibilities. These powers and responsibilities include, for example, construction and/or acquisition of stormwater management facilities, entrances and entrance landscaping, wetland and environmental mitigation, offsite improvements, utility improvements, and parks and amenities.

DISCLOSURE OF PUBLIC FINANCING AND MAINTENANCE OF IMPROVEMENTS TO REAL PROPERTY UNDERTAKEN BY THE GRAND OAKS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

Under Florida law, community development districts are required to take affirmative steps to provide for the full disclosure of information relating to the public financing and maintenance of improvements to real property undertaken by such districts. The law specifically provides that this information shall be made available to all persons currently residing within the District and to all prospective District residents. The following information describing the Grand Oaks Community Development District and the assessments, fees and charges that may be levied within the District to pay for certain community infrastructure is provided to fulfill this statutory requirement.

What is the District and how is it governed?

The District is an independent special taxing district, created pursuant to and existing under the provisions of Chapter 190, Florida Statutes (the "Act"), and established by Ordinance 2018-47 enacted by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County, Florida, effective as of August 24, 2018. The District encompasses approximately 450 acres located entirely within the boundaries of St. Johns County, Florida. As a local unit of special-purpose government, the District provides an alternative means for planning, financing, constructing, operating and maintaining various public improvements and community facilities within its jurisdiction.

The District is governed by a five-member Board of Supervisors (the "Board"), the members of which must be residents of the State and citizens of the United States. Board members were elected on an at-large basis by the owners of property within the District, each landowner being entitled to one vote for each acre of land with fractions thereof rounded upward to the nearest whole number. Elections are then held every two years in November. Commencing when both (i) six years after the initial appointment of Supervisors have passed and (ii) the District has attained a minimum of two hundred and fifty (250) qualified electors,

Supervisors whose terms are expiring will begin to be elected by qualified electors of the District. A "qualified elector" in this instance is any person at least eighteen (18) years of age who is a citizen of the United States, a legal resident of Florida and of the District, and who is also registered with the Supervisor of Elections to vote in St. Johns County. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if at any time the Board proposes to exercise its ad valorem taxing power, it shall, prior to the exercise of such power, call an election at which all members of the Board shall be elected by qualified electors of the District.

Board meetings are noticed in a local newspaper and conducted in a public forum in which public participation is permitted. Consistent with Florida's public records laws, the records of the District are available for public inspection during normal business hours. Elected members of the Board are similarly bound by the State's open meetings law and are generally subject to the same disclosure requirements as other elected officials under the State's ethics laws.

What infrastructure improvements does the District provide and how are the improvements paid for?

The District is comprised of approximately 450 acres located entirely within St. Johns County, Florida. The legal description of the lands encompassed within the District is attached hereto as **Exhibit A.** The public infrastructure necessary to support the District's development program includes, but is not limited to: stormwater management facilities, entrances and entrance landscaping, wetland and environmental mitigation, offsite improvements, and water and sewer utility improvements, and parks and amenities. These infrastructure improvements are more fully detailed below.

To plan the infrastructure improvements necessary for the District, the District adopted a *Master Engineer's Report* dated August 2018, as updated and supplemented by the *Supplemental Engineer's Report* dated January 30, 2019 and the *Supplemental Engineer's Report for Assessment Area 2 and Assessment Area 3* dated August 17, 2020, which details all of the improvements contemplated for the completion of the infrastructure of the District (together, the "Capital Improvement Plan"). Copies of the Capital Improvement Plan are available for review at the District's office.

These public infrastructure improvements have been or will be funded by the District's sale of bonds. On November 1, 2018, the Circuit Court of the State of Florida, in and for St. Johns County, Florida, entered a Final Judgment validating the District's ability to issue an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$26,000,000 in Special Assessment Revenue Bonds for the funding of the Capital Improvement Plan.

On October 22, 2018, the District issued its \$2,435,000 Special Assessment Revenue Bond Anticipation Notes, Series 2018 (the "Series 2018 Notes") for the purpose of financing a portion of the costs associated with the acquisition, construction and installation of the Capital Improvement Plan.

On April 29, 2019, the District issued its \$11,460,000 Special Assessment Revenue Bonds, Series 2019A (the "Series 2019A Bonds") for the purpose of paying off the outstanding Series 2018 Notes and financing a portion of the costs associated with the acquisition, construction and installation of Phase 1 of the Capital Improvement Plan.

On September 24, 2020, the District issued its \$15,490,000 Special Assessment Revenue Bonds, Series 2020 (Assessment Area 2) (the "Series 2020 Bonds") for the purpose of financing a portion of the costs associated with the acquisition, construction and installation of Phase 2 the Capital Improvement Plan.

On November 17, 2021, the District issued its \$5,295,000 Special Assessment Revenue Bonds, Series 2021 (Assessment Area 3) (the "Series 2021 Bonds") for the purpose of financing a portion of the costs associated with the acquisition, construction and installation of Phase 2 the Capital Improvement Plan.

Stormwater Management Facilities

The District will construct and/or acquire drainage systems that collect and treat stormwater by temporarily holding in on-site retention/settlement basins before discharge to the regional drainage system. The stormwater collection system will consist of a stabilized subgrade, lime rock base, asphalt and curbs with inlets, piping systems and ponds. These will all be constructed consistent with the specifications of St. Johns County ("County") and the St. Johns River Water Management District ("SJRWMD"). The stormwater master plan for the project is to assure that adequate stormwater management facilities are available to provide stormwater management capacity for the final development and meet regulatory requirements. The plan identifies peak discharge rates, water quality requirements, 100-year floodplain elevations, and groundwater flows. For each phase, final design of the proposed stormwater drainage system will be reviewed and approved by SJRWMD and the County prior to construction. The drainage system will maintain existing drainage patterns to the greatest extent possible. The stormwater retention ponds will be wet detention biological treatment facilities to provide for the treatment of stormwater. As part of the overall SJRWMD stormwater permit, mitigation is required for wetland impacts. The plan provides for mitigation which includes selective clearing, earthwork and wetland plantings for enhancement with the preservation areas. The removal of surface drainage from the roadways will be accomplished by storm sewer systems, including curb and gutter, inlets and pipes along each side of the roadways that will collect and convey surface drainage to stormwater retention ponds located along the roadways. Protection of the road base material from undermining will be accomplished by underdrain systems as needed, which will bleed off excess groundwater and discharge to the roadside storm sewer system. In several areas, the removal of surface drainage from the roadways, and the protection of the road base materials from undermining on those roadways, will be accomplished with grassed swales along each side of the roadways. This will bleed off excess groundwater and convey surface drainage to stormwater retention ponds located along the roadways. The costs of the stormwater management facilities include clearing, earthwork operations to ensure a continuously functioning stormwater system, drainage structures and wetland mitigation planting The ponds are part of an integrated stormwater management and wetland maintenance. mitigation system.

Entrances and Entrance Landscape

The District intends to construct monumentation and entry landscaping, including entrance and street tree plantings along the interior streets of the District.

Wetland/Environmental Compliance and Mitigation

The District anticipates obtaining approximately 89 acres of wetlands preservation lands, purchasing offsite wetland mitigation, and obtaining or enhancing wetlands to meet and ensure continued compliance with the requirements of the environmental permits.

Roadway Improvements

The District anticipates financing and constructing certain roadway improvements within the District. Roadway improvements will consist of grading, paving, striping, erosion control, surveying, curbs and sidewalk. Roadway improvements will be constructed to St. Johns County standards but are anticipated to be owned and maintained by the District.

Offsite Improvements

The District will make improvements outside of the District boundary that include intersection improvements in front of the project entrance along State Road 16, which may include but are not necessarily limited to, turn lanes and street lighting improvements.

Water and Sewer Utility Improvements

Water and sewer improvements, which will consist of water distribution, wastewater collection and reuse water distribution systems, are anticipated to be constructed by the District and dedicated to the County's public utilities, which will provide service to the residents. This includes wastewater pumping stations and force mains. Water and sewer lines are currently available to the site along State Road 16. The District will also construct a potable water line loop that is approximately 3.5 miles long, including construction of a 20" potable water transmission within the right-of-way of future County Road 2209.

Parks and Amenities

The District intends to finance and construct certain parks and recreational facilities within the District which may include a main clubhouse, pool, pickleball courts, a dog park and other small parks throughout the District.

Assessments, Fees and Charges

The costs of acquisition or construction of a portion of these infrastructure improvements have been financed by the District through the sale of the Series 2019A Bonds, Series 2020

Bonds, and Series 2021 Bonds. The annual debt service payments, including interest due thereon, are payable solely from and secured by the levy of non-ad valorem or special assessments against lands within the District which benefit from the construction, acquisition, establishment and operation of the District's improvements. The annual debt service obligations of the District which must be defrayed by annual assessments upon each parcel of land or platted lot will depend upon the type of property purchased. The current maximum annual debt service assessment levels for property within the District for the Series 2019A Bonds (the "Series 2019 Debt Service Assessments"), the Series 2020 Bonds (the "Series 2020 Debt Service Assessments," together with the Series 2019 Debt Assessments and Series 2020 Debt Service Assessments, the "Debt Service Assessments") may be obtained from the District Manager. Interested persons are encouraged to contact the District Manager for information regarding special assessments on a particular lot or parcel of lands. A copy of the District's assessment methodology and assessment roll are available for review at the District's office.

The Debt Service Assessments exclude any operations and maintenance assessments ("O&M Assessments") which may be determined and calculated annually by the District's Board of Supervisors and are levied against benefitted lands in the District.

A detailed description of all costs and allocations which result in the formulation of the Debt Service Assessments and the O&M Assessments is available for public inspection upon request.

The Capital Improvement Plan and financing plan of the District infrastructure as presented herein reflect the District's current intentions, and the District expressly reserves the right in its sole discretion to change those plans at any time. Additionally, the District may undertake the construction, reconstruction, acquisition, or installation of future improvements and facilities, which may be financed by bonds, notes, or other methods authorized by Chapter 190, Florida Statutes.

Method of Collection

The District's Debt Service Assessments, and/or O&M Assessments may appear on that portion of the annual real estate tax notice entitled "non-ad valorem assessments," and to the extent that it is, will be collected by the St. Johns County Tax Collector in the same manner as county ad valorem taxes. Each property owner must pay both ad valorem and non-ad valorem assessments at the same time. Property owners will, however, be entitled to the same discounts as provided for ad valorem taxes. As with any tax notice, if all taxes and assessments due are not paid within the prescribed time limit, the tax collector is required to sell tax certificates which, if not timely redeemed, may result in the loss of title to the property. The District may also elect to collect the assessment directly.

This description of the District's operation, services and financing structure is intended to provide assistance to landowners and purchasers concerning the important role that the District plays in providing infrastructure improvements essential to the use and development of this
